Notes:

-An Online Degree course that has a specific Norwich course equivalent also fulfills a required general education competency (example EV103 meets the requirement for SCIE301 in the SSDA or CJ programs, but would also fulfill a required general education competency in BSBA, Cyber, etc.

-An Online Degree course noted as “Lower Division Free Elective” in the Norwich column does not fulfill either a required course or a required general education competency, but will be applied as an elective toward the 30 or 60 credit threshold (depending on program) required for admission as a matriculating student.

-The Online Degree course CS101 Introduction to Programming counts, at present, as 3 Lower Division Free Elective Credits. However, a Norwich course currently under development (CYBR110) will be the equivalent once it is available. This can be revised via addendum at that time.
